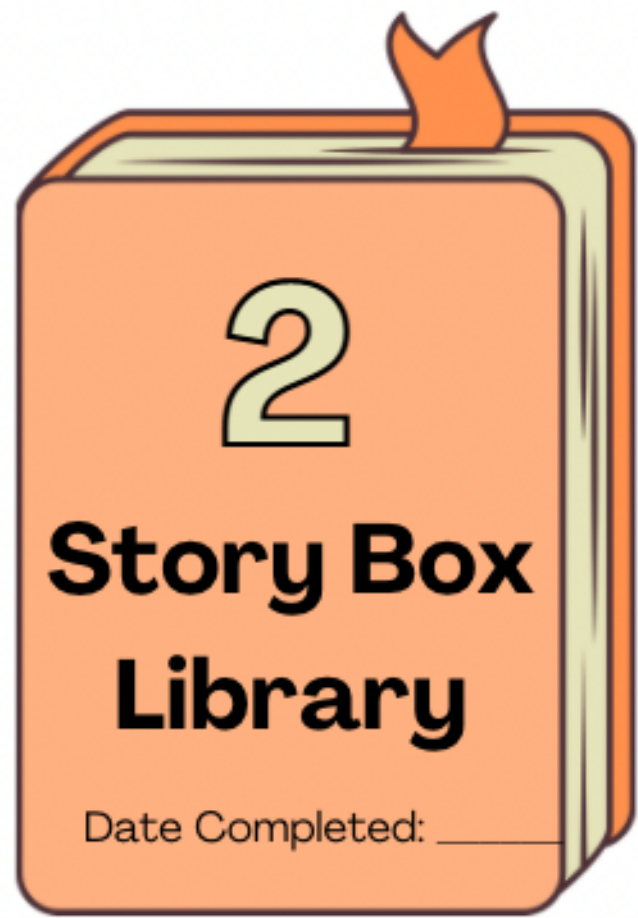






Dress Up

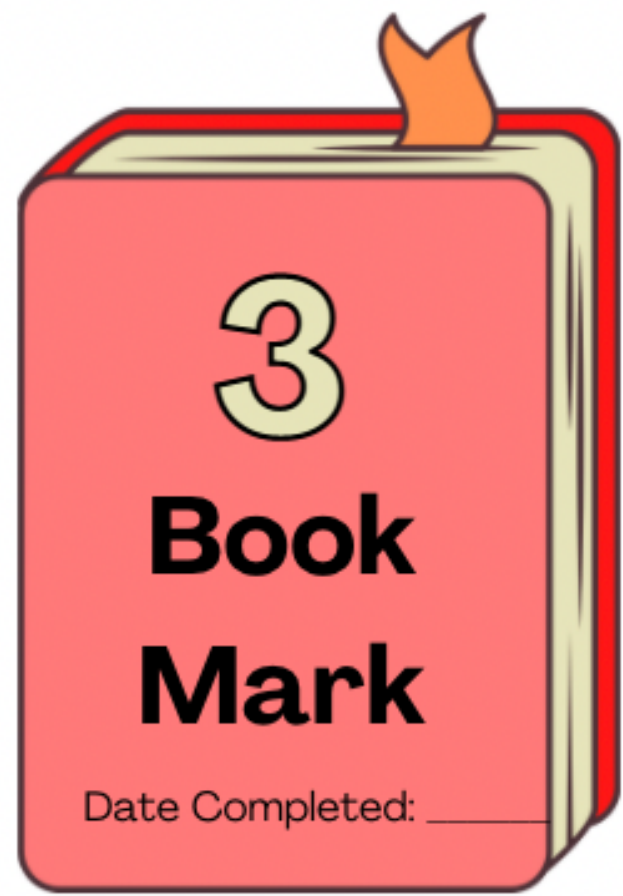
